Unit 4 - Term 1 in Pre Primary

Term 1 has been a busy term for us in Pre Primary. It is our first-time attending school full-time which has been quite exhausting for us sometimes! We didn't let that stop us though as we dived straight into learning (don't worry though, we still learn through play)!



Literacy

As we are 'big kids' now, we have finished our Phase 2 progression for Letters and Sounds. We have now learnt 23 phonemes that we are busy applying into our newfound reading and spelling skills. Take a look at us stringing together sounds that we can hear in words to attempt to write a caption – everyone did a fabulous job with this tricky skill. Our focus text in Talk 4 Writing this Term was "The Three Little Pigs". We had a lot of fun building our houses out of bricks, sticks and straw!













Numeracy

Term 1 has had a major focus on numbers! We have been learning about number names, numerals, and quantities to represent them. Don't forget to keep counting at home to help us practice! Mrs Leggatt has been busy teaching measurement, particularly the Days of the week!

Art

Term 1 has been all about colours, specifically warm and cool colours! We have been doing lots of projects to practice remembering which colours are warm (yellow, orange, red) and which are cool (blue, green, purple). Here are some photos of us choosing which materials we would like to use to create a collage of a 'warm wolf' and his 'cool breath'!





PBS Reward Day

We were so lucky in Term 1 to have a Hospital Familiarisation Incursion. The point of the incursion is to familiarise our students with some tests and procedures that may happen if we need to visit the hospital. This includes having our blood pressure tested, temperature tested, what a needle looks like (the toy doll was even given one for a demo) and what a stethoscope is. We were able to then play doctor with the toys and even got to play on a wheelchair! It was a fun experience for the students and hopefully it will make future trips to the doctors a bit easier for everyone.

Easter Raffle


