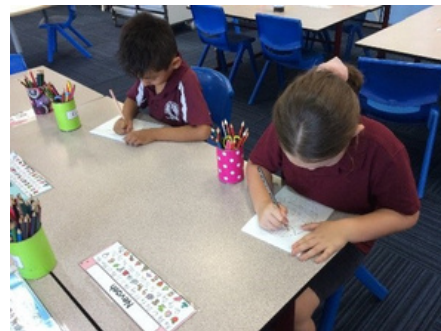
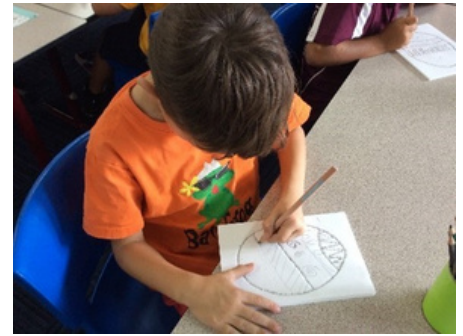
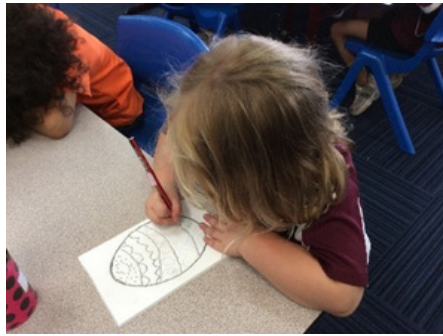

During term 1 all students from room 2 did some print making as one of our Visual Arts projects.

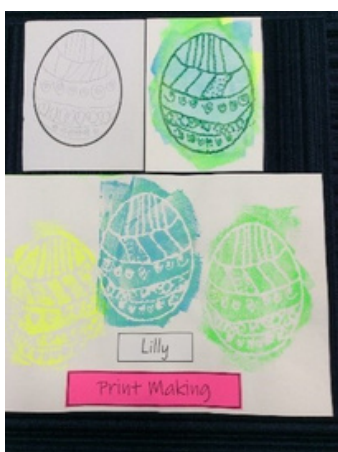
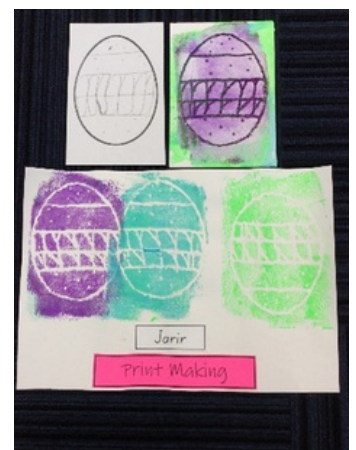
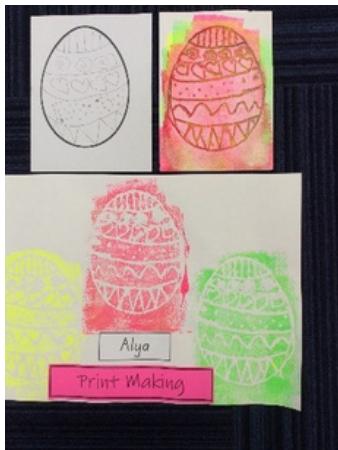
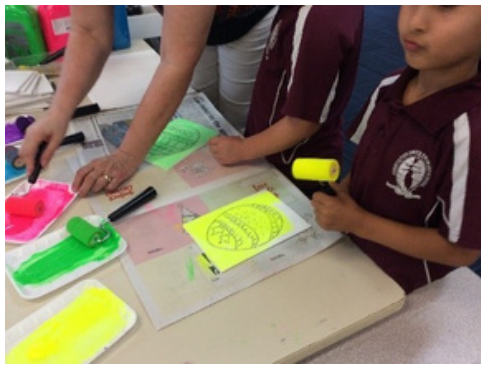
This process involved following a procedure, which was also one of the text types that we learnt about during our 'Talk for Writing' lessons.

First, we created a design of the patterns and shapes that we wanted on our egg. Next, we transferred the design to a piece of foam board and carefully etched this design into the foam using a sharp pencil.



After that, we used a roller to apply a light coat of paint onto the foam. Finally, we placed the painted foam onto a sheet of paper and pressed firmly to transfer the print to the paper. We repeated the painting of the foam another 2 times, using different coloured paints each time.





We were all very happy with our completed prints!

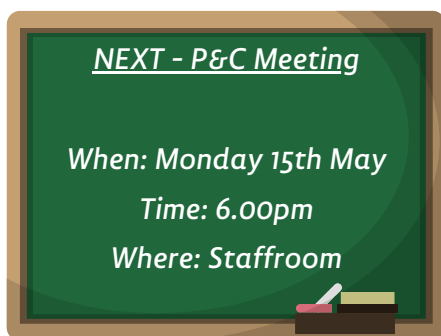
The P&C hopes everyone had a wonderful school holidays 😊
