PB Reward - Bricks 4 Kids & Baby Animal Farm


In Week 10, our students who achieved their Personal Best Reward were treated to some very special activities!

Classroom Item - Auslan

Auslan Term 3 Update- A Busy and Brilliant Term

What a fantastic and productive Term 3 it has been in Auslan! Our students have been immersed in learning a wide range of vocabulary and grammar, with a strong focus on food, household items, and Auslan sentence structure.

Year 1/2 students have made incredible progress with the Auslan Alphabet. Many can now sign the entire alphabet with mostly correct handshapes in under a minute, what an achievement! During our food unit, they loved learning fruit and vegetable signs, expressing their likes and dislikes, and playing the ever-popular Fruit and Vegetable Salad game (when the weather allowed!).

Year 3 students have been busy using iPads to create food posters, showcasing the correct handshape, location and movement for their chosen signs. They also enjoyed learning household item signs and playing games like 'Guess Which Room I'm from' to reinforce their vocabulary.

Year 4 students have gone above and beyond — learning food and household signs and even writing and filming their own Auslan weather reports! We may have some future weather presenters in the making.

Year 5 students have been focusing on and mastering basic Auslan grammar. A highlight this term was writing and signing instructional scripts on How to Make a Jam Sandwich... Let's just say... some of the sandwiches turned out very interesting due to missing or unclear instructions – lots of laughs were had.

Year 6 students have shown a great understanding of Auslan grammar and demonstrated their skills by signing the ingredients and steps to make a hamburger. They've also enjoyed watching Auslan in the media and are becoming confident in interpreting fingerspelling and signed content.

Auslan is a rich and visual language with its own unique grammar. For example, while English follows a Subject-Verb-Object structure (e.g. I am going to the shop tomorrow), Auslan uses a Time-Topic-Comment structure (e.g. Tomorrow shop I go). Our students are doing an amazing job adapting to this and developing their communication skills in this beautiful language.

National Week of Deaf People is from the 22nd - 26th of September.

Scitech is celebrating National Week of Deaf People on Tuesday, 30th September. If you visit the Science Theatre and Planetarium, there will be Auslan interpreters and captions all day. You can test and practice your Auslan skills while you explore and join in the fun. Everyone can join in and have fun together!
