When applying, please ensure you have the following relevant documents attached: 1 x proof of address, Birth Certificate, Australian Citizenship Paper or Visa/Passport (if applicable), and an Immunisation History statement downloaded from the Medicare website, which must be dated within the last two months.




Classroom Item - Room 10 - Year 3
